AUDIO ENGINEERING PROGRAM ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS & REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

ABOUT THE ELLIS MARSALIS CENTER FOR MUSIC

The Ellis Marsalis Center for Music (EMCM) is a place where children are at the heart of our mission in training the next generation of New Orleans musicians. We see music lessons and arts education as tools that help young people learn discipline and dedication and explore them their creativity.

In the fall and spring, we operate an after-school and Saturday program that focuses on teaching the fundamentals of instrumental music, dance, and music theory, in addition to computer instruction/coding and homework help.

We engage students in sound engineering. Our curriculum offers the opportunity to learn live sound, audio editing, studio techniques, and much more. Enrollment is limited.

EMCM has teamed up with Berklee College of Music to offer a program in the technical aspects of recording, streaming, and media production for high school students. This program will teach participants the fundamentals of audio engineering and engage them in hands-on training led by professionals in the field. Students will experience a rigorous course load that will equip them with the necessary skill to transition into post-secondary education or move into the workforce.

In the summer, we engage our youth through a wide array of music, dance, reading and math instruction, and coding to enhance and cultivate their creativity.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Students must at least be in 11th grade or higher.
- Priority is given to students living in the Musician's Village and the surrounding Upper 9th Ward neighborhood which includes the following zip codes: 70117, 70126, 70127, 70128, 70129, 70032, and 70122. Students living outside those areas may contact the office to determine eligibility.
- Prior musical experience is **not** required for new students.
- Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis based upon full payment of fees.
- Registration fees are not refundable.
- Enrollment is limited.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Registration forms for the Audio Engineering program are available by request by contacting our program specialist at <u>aleduff@ellismarsaliscenter.org</u>.
- Fill out one form per child and submit the \$30.00 registration fee via credit card over the phone. The
 registration fee is non-refundable. We accept credit or debit cards only. There is a \$1.25 processing
 fee for credit cards. EMCM does not accept checks. Registration is not complete until forms and
 funds are collected.
- If the classes are full for the session, you will be added to the program waiting list.
- Students accepted into the program will be notified no later than Friday, August 18, 2023.
